Technology is everywhere, except where we need it the most—***we don't have***

enough technology in our schools. School budgets don't allow for new technology or updates. A past LEF campaign and generous donors helped to make strides to fill this gap for our children. Despite these efforts, there are still many classrooms not equipped. The district has done an evaluation of what technology equipment they have and LEF did a survey of the staff as to what they would like to have in their classrooms. Overwhelmingly, the results showed that the staff felt a few basic technology items for now would be a huge help in teaching their students. Here are the **Basic 4 items: a document camera, a projector, a connected computer for the teacher, and a widescreen projector screen.** Of course, there are other pieces of technology on their "wish lists", but these Basic 4 items are essential for enhancing the teaching of the students.

LEF has launched a Reach Higher Technology Campaign to raise funds to equip **EVERY** classroom in the Lakeshore School District with the Basic 4. The cost to equip and install these items is \$2,000 per classroom. LEF's goal is to raise these funds by the end of the school year, so that these items can be purchased and hopefully installed for teachers to begin using them next fall.

Technology is vital these days in the education of our students. We need to give them the tools to best prepare them for their futures. We need your help to reach this goal.

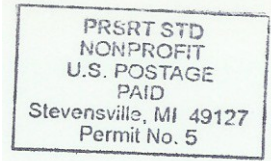
