Planning has begun for the 2012-2013 school year. We are working through our in-depth process to create grade level sections and place students.

Our comprehensive process of creating new classroom combinations for next year is done as a team of sending and receiving teachers, with feedback from specialists, the counselor and principal. Detailed information cards are filled out on each student in order to assist in the process. These placements are always tentative, since teacher assignments are not final until August due to retirements, moves and enrollment fluctuations. Our obligation as educators is to strive for the best educational setting for EVERY CHILD. We group students for instructional purposes, and placing them in classes based on any other factors would defeat this purpose. When we assemble classes, we try to make them heterogeneous. This involves balancing the number of boys and girls, academic skill levels/needs, personality types, learning styles, friendship needs, special programs and support services (such as speech therapy), as well as class size. You can see that this is a complicated, thorough process!

We appreciate your trust and support. If you as a parent have a special concern regarding your child's placement please put it in writing to me or make an appointment to discuss it in person. Your child's success in school is our priority!

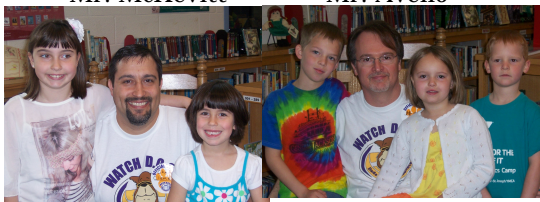

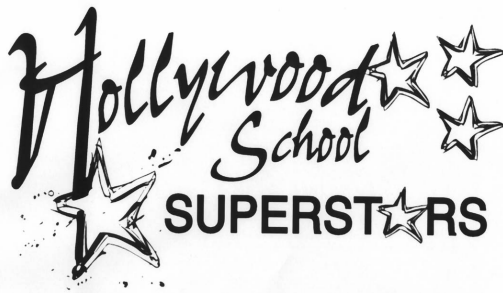
