Lory’s Place Peer Support Group

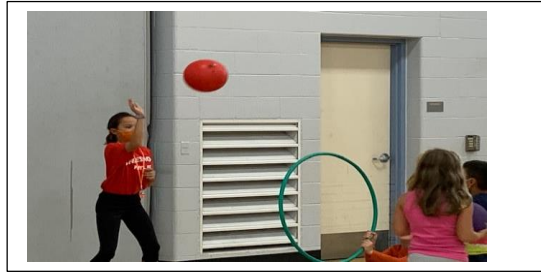
