2022-2023 Schools of Choice Notice

Lakeshore Public Schools announces that it is opening the application period for non-resident enrollment as a Schools of Choice student to start the 2022-2023 school year from May 2-31, 2022.

The student must be a resident of another school district within Berrien County.

Application Deadline: All applications must be **received by May 31, 2022**. Parents will be notified by June 15, 2022 of the status of their application.

General Information:

1. Complete one form for each child. All children within a family that apply are considered on an individual grade level basis.
2. Preference is given to siblings of students already enrolled here under Schools of Choice.
3. If your child is currently a student at Lakeshore and has moved outside the district boundaries, a Schools of Choice application must be submitted during this open window in order to be eligible to continue enrollment.
4. If we receive more applications for a grade level than openings, a random drawing will occur. Those that are eligible and not selected are put on a waiting list.

We will accept a minimum of one student per grade from Young 5's through 12th grade.

Transportation: Transportation is not provided by the school and is the responsibility of the parent or guardian.

Attendance: If your child is accepted as a Schools of Choice student, you are committing to having your child in school daily and on time. You are also committing to being involved in your child's education.

Documentation: If your child is accepted, **at a later date** you will be required to supply all of the following documentation and complete an enrollment packet. Only the application is needed at this time:

- Certified Birth Certificate
- Immunization Records
- Driver's License
- One utility bill with current address as the 'service address' (Gas, Electric, Cable, or Water)
- Recent Property Tax Bill or Rental Agreement
