Reporting of Drills

Public Act 12 of 2014 (an act to amend 1941 PA 207) requires all schools to post on their website when school safety drills are completed. We offer this optional service to track your compliance. Part of "coordination" means the reporting and learning from lessons that were learned during the drill in what is known as an after action report. This form is designed to record information related to that.
